4 Do I have an area that is protected from strong wind?

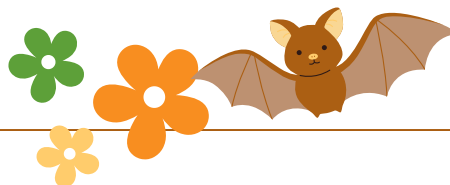
5 What species of native pollinators are in my area?

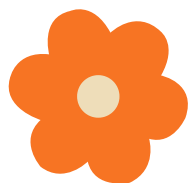

8 Is the location convenient for me to enjoy my garden?

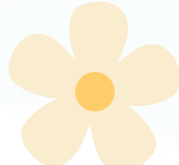
